Hospitality & Catering

Course Overview:

This course is ideal for those who have an interest in working in the hospitality and catering industry. Students will learn new and exciting practical skills and gain experience in real-life customer-facing environments in a well-equipped commercial kitchen and through front of house duties in our community cafe.

The course covers all the basic duties you would need to know how to perform when becoming a chef, from maintaining a safe place of work to preparing and baking food items. Students are taught about and assessed in the fundamentals of catering.

Childcare

Course Overview:

The course also provides learners with an insight into the practical qualities they require, not only for uniformed services, but also for employment in general.





Construction

This course will help learners gain the skills and knowledge needed to work in the construction industry. Success on this course would prepare and enable learners to undertake a CSCS test for labourers at an approved centre.
